

Spetisbury CofE Primary School – Outcomes 2023–2024

Our 2024 outcomes represent an exceptional year for the school. Pupils achieved highly across the curriculum, placing the school among the strongest performers nationally while continuing to reflect the warmth, care and ambition that define our community. Behind every statistic is a child who has been supported, encouraged and inspired to succeed.

Highlights

- 96% of pupils achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics combined (national: 61%), placing the school in the 99th percentile nationally.
- Early Years outcomes were particularly strong, with 84% of children achieving a Good Level of Development compared with 68% nationally.
- 89% of pupils passed the Year 1 phonics screening check, well above the national figure of 80%.
- Mathematics was a standout strength; 96% of pupils reached the expected standard compared with 73% nationally.
- 96% of pupils met the expected standard in science, significantly above the national figure of 81%.
